

Installation Specifications

At www.Coronado.com product specifications can be downloaded in CSI format. Coronado gives the customer control over how the stone should be installed.

Choices specific to Idaho Drystack

Standard Colors:	Antique Buff, Aspen, Cape Cod Grey, Carmel Mountain, Chablis, Denver Blend, Grey Quartzite, Smokey Grey, (Any Standard or Custom Color)_____
Grout Joint Width:	Drystack, Standard 1/2" Grout Joint
Grout Joint Depth:	Deep Raked, Full Brushed, Full Tooled
Grout Joint Color:	Natural Grey, Natural Off-White, (Complementary Color)_____

Special Installation Notes

Pattern:	Stone should not be installed in a vertical position. Select stones from several different boxes to ensure a proper blend of size and color variation. See brochure photos for recommended installation pattern.
Chalk Lines:	Should be used by installer to ensure a straight and level pattern.
Vertical Joints:	Should be no longer than 4" to 6" on average.
Horizontal Joints:	Should not exceed 6' to 8'.

Description: Idaho Drystack is comprised of individual stones designed in modular sizes for easy installation.

Sizes: Stones are 1", 2", 3" and 4" in height and from 4" to 16" in length.

Thickness: 1 1/4" to 2"

Packaging: Available in big boxes (100 square feet) or Dura-Paks (12.5 square feet). **Square-foot coverage for Idaho Drystack is based on installation with tightly-fitted joints.**

Sealing: Not required. However, if installed on an exterior exposed to excessive water from runoff or improper drainage, we suggest the product be sealed in that particular area to protect it from staining or spalling during freeze-thaw cycles.

Accessories: Corners, Matching Pavers, Wall Caps, Post Caps and more. (See Accessories section of binder)
